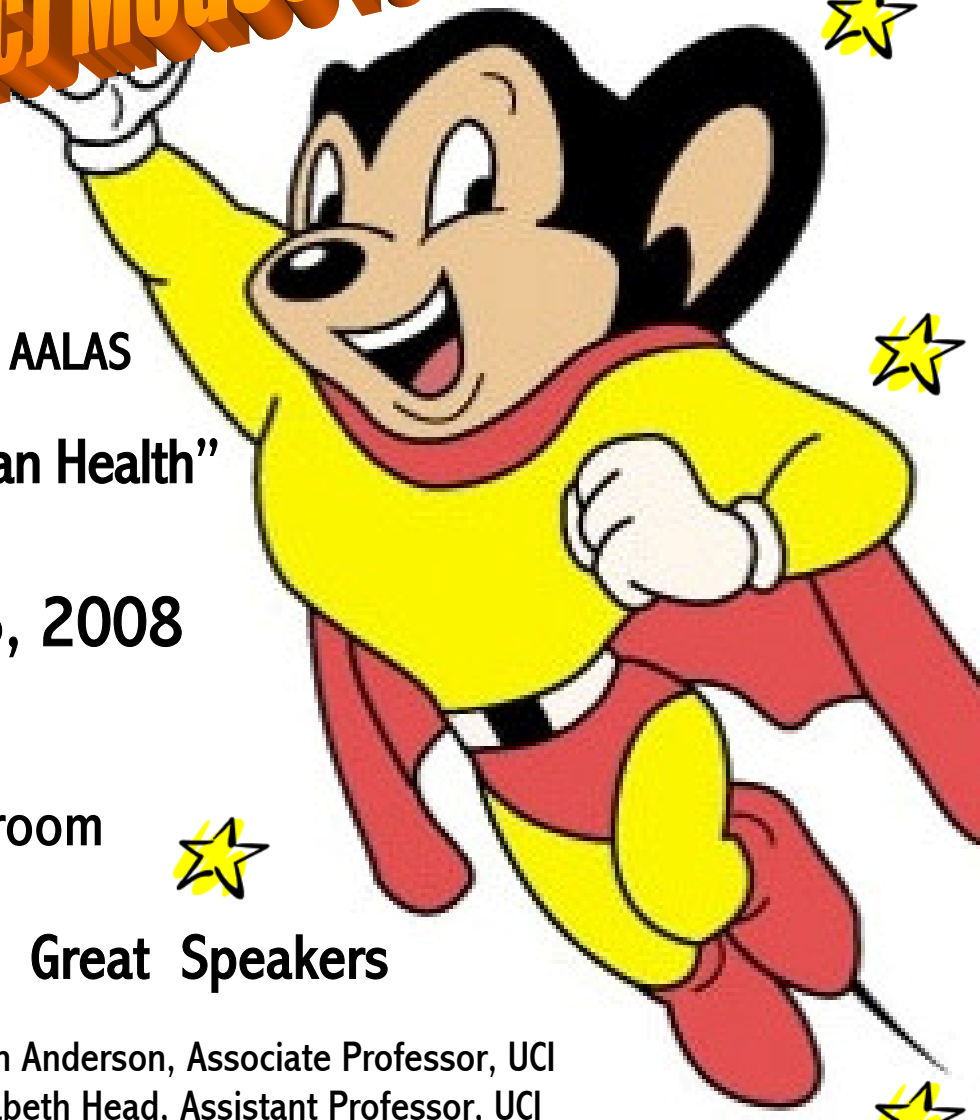

Transgenic Mouse Symposium, UC-Irvine

We have a stimulating program, including speakers from UCI, UC-Davis, The Scripps Research Institute, and UCLA. Your registration fee covers the cost of parking, breakfast, lunch, and a coffee break. **We will reserve a certain number of parking spaces in advance. Once those are gone, you will have to pay \$10 at the entrance, so please carpool and come early.**

 Check-in and the continental breakfast are from 8:00 to 9:00 AM. The first talk will begin after the opening remarks at 9:00. All talks will take place in Pacific Ballroom A in the lower level of the Student Center at UCI. Vendor tables will be set up in the adjoining Pacific Ballrooms B and C. The nearest entrance is off Pereira Drive, directly across the street from the parking structure. Each vendor has been asked to raffle off a door prize worth about \$25, so be sure to visit as many vendors as possible to increase your chances of winning a prize. The raffle will take place at the end of the symposium, and you must be present to win.



Directions to the Student Center at UCI



Parking is located just across Pereira Drive from the Student Center, which is building 113 on the UCI campus map. See http://today.uci.edu/pdf/UCI_08_map_campus.pdf.

From the northwest:

Take the 405 south to Jamboree Road; go south on Jamboree about 1 mile and turn left on Campus Drive. Just past the intersection with University Drive, turn right on West Peltason, then immediately turn left onto Pereira Drive. Enter the parking structure on the left and request a pass from the attendant. The Student Center is just across Pereira from the parking structure. Follow the signs to Pacific Ballroom A.

From the south:

If you are starting south of the point where the 73 (San Joaquin Hills Tollroad) splits off from the 5, and you don't mind paying the toll, you may take the 73 north to the University Drive exit. Turn right on University, go about 1 mile to Campus Drive, turn right on Campus, and proceed as above.

If you don't want to take the 73, take the 405 north to the University Drive/Jeffrey Road exit. Turn left onto University, proceed about 2 miles to Campus Drive, turn left on Campus, and proceed as above.

From the northeast:

Take the 55 south to the 405 south, exit the 405 at Jamboree and proceed as per the directions from the northwest.
